**PACKING**

All contestants are responsible for the packaging, transporting and proper handling of their competition entries. No entry may exceed 40 pounds in weight or exceed more than two or three feet in its longest dimension (depending on the category entered.)

**DELIVERY**

All items must be brought to EXCEL Convention at registration and removed from the premises Friday night after award ceremony.

**DISPLAY**

Entries must have a typed or neatly printed display card or label securely attached and clearly visible in the following format:

Repurpose - to give a new purpose or use

Start with any item (i.e. non-wearable fabric, wood, plastic, wire, etc.) and what it ends up is up to you.

Entries will be judged on originality, quality of workmanship, overall presentation, and requirements met.

1. Repurposed useable items must be able to withstand intended use (i.e. outdoor items must be weather resistant).
2. New or used items may be repurposed.
3. Include a photo of the original item.
4. Include a small report explaining how you repurposed your item.
5. No entry may exceed 40 pounds in weight or exceed more than two or three feet in its longest dimension.
